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## Introduction to Jacquard Weaving

Take advantage of this rare opportunity to use a Jacquard loom under the guidance of experienced weavers. Workshops with 4-6 people will be held at (TAD) the Textile Arts Department and Studio located on the second floor of MakerLabs at 780 East Cordova St, Vancouver.

### Intro to Jacquard weaving

**3 sessions Monday's Sept. 19<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, Oct. 3, 2016 6-9pm + some additional individual loom access**

In this course you will learn how to create Jacquard weavings from your original drawings, images or designs using Photoshop. Please bring several images on a USB Drive to your first class.

You will create a file using simple weave structures in black and white or black with one colour. Weaving will be done on a computerized AVL Jacq3G Jacquard loom for a small piece (24" wide x 12-16" high. (60 cm x 40 cm ) 720 x 360 pixels.

#### Requirements:

A weaving background is helpful but not required and projects can be adapted to focus more on the design process or weaving; people will weave their own pieces outside of class time or can have them woven by a technician. Some basic image manipulation with Photoshop is needed and you should have your own laptop with some version of Photoshop or Photoshop Elements; some access to a shared computer will be available.

**Costs:** \$200 (This cost includes materials)

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### Weave your own project on the Jacquard loom (Intermediate)

**3 sessions Wednesday's September 21, 28, October 5 1-4pm + some additional individual loom access**

#### 3 sessions + scheduled weaving

You will focus on creating your own woven piece using single weft or multiple weft colours. Please bring a few designs or images to your first class to discuss possible results. We will review and expand on the basic processes of design/image manipulation in creating a Jacquard weaving file. You will work on your own design and will have access to an extensive library of weaves. You will weave samples in class and some of the projects and be given access to weave at a scheduled time outside class time. Your project can be up to 36" long by 24" or 60 cm or 100 cm.

#### Requirements:

Intro to Jacquard weaving or previous experience with Jacquard weaving; you will need access to Photoshop and a computer; previous weaving is desirable, although arrangements can be made to have your file woven for added costs.

**Costs:** \$240 (This cost includes materials)
